NYIT-Vancouver campus offers a general MBA and MBA with concentrations in either Finance or Tourism. Whether you have just completed your undergraduate degree, or have been working in your chosen field for years, the prestigious New York Institute of Technology (NYIT) Master of Business Administration (MBA) Program offers you a great opportunity to pursue your professional goals. NYIT's highly-ranked MBA is world-recognized for its high standards in business education.

The NYIT MBA program is approved in New York and offered in Vancouver under the written consent of the Ministry of Advanced Education in British Columbia. Courses are taught by academically and professionally qualified professors from NYIT's New York campuses and local faculty. By focusing on the application of modern business theories to problems that managers face in the public and private sectors in today's global economy, the curriculum emphasizes career-oriented technologies and practices that provide graduates with a competitive advantage. The program is open to all qualified students regardless of their undergraduate major.

The program offers limitless opportunities for students to pursue a high quality career-oriented business education with a global edge. Students enjoy a small class size and flexible class schedules that accommodate working professionals. They also receive personal attention given by outstanding

professors with hands-on experience from the business sector. NYIT, with its presence in both Atlantic and Pacific gateways (New York, Vancouver, China and the Middle East), provides students with opportunities to become competitive in today's global economy.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Hold a bachelor's degree or its equivalent from an accredited college or university.
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale).
- Demonstrate English proficiency. This can be done by submitting the Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS):

TOEFL: A minimum written-based score of 550, a minimum computer-based score of 213, or a minimum Internet-based score of 79 is required for admission.

IELTS: A minimum score of 6.0 is required for admission.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

There are six intakes in every academic year: generally, January and March (Spring), May and June (Summer) and September and November (Fall) and applications are accepted year round. Students can generally complete the MBA program in about 12-15 months, excluding the completion of waivable courses. MBA with concentrations will take longer to complete.

To apply you need to submit the following:

- NYIT global application for
- A non-refundable application fee in the amount of USD 50.
- Official academic transcripts from bachelor degree studies accompanied by a certified translation to English if transcripts are issued in a language other than English.
- Proof of completion of a four year bachelor degree from an accredited institution of higher education. Three year bachelor degrees may be eligible.
- Proof of English proficiency (TOEFL or IELTS) This is not required if you have completed your undergraduate degree from an accredited North American institution.
- A copy of passport ID page.
- Resume or C.V. (1-2 pages) and Statement of Purpose or Letter of Intent.

TUITION ESTIMATES

For students requiring 30 credits = USD 26,100

(Non-waivable core 21 credits + elective 9 credits)

Note: NYIT admission department will determine as to how many credits the student must take to complete the MBA.

For students requiring 48 credits hours = USD 41,760

(Non-waivable core 21 credits + Electives 9 credits + waivable core 18 credits)

Students pursuing MBA with concentrations (Finance or Tourism) are required to take 15 credits in the area of their concentration so their tuition fee will be higher.

Note: NYIT admission department will determine as to how many credits the student must take to complete the MBA.

Application fee = USD 50 (non-refundable)

Tuition per credit = USD 870

USD 2,250 Vancouver Graduate Scholar Award

International and domestic students may be considered for the USD 2,250 per year "Vancouver Graduate Scholar Award." This academic, merit-based scholarship provides recognition for graduate students who, by means of their credentials, have demonstrated academic excellence during their undergraduate education as well as met specific requirments while students of the program. The award consists of a USD 2,250 per year applied towards the tuition in the amount of USD 750 to each fall, spring and summer semesters.

FINANCIAL AID

Financial aid is available to Canadian citizens and permanent residents.

NYIT Vancouver offers new intakes every 8 weeks. The next intakes are October 28th and January 6th, 2014.
